


With reference to your application and subsequent correspondence with the school/inspection in this regard, I convey the grant for recognition to the **Sushila Devi Harishchandra Academy Bhalasavagaj, Block Bhagwanpur, Haridwar** for class Pre-Primary to class 8th for a period of Three years wef 1-4-2022 to 31-3-2025

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

1. The grant for recognition is not extendable and does not in any way imply any obligation to Recognition/affiliate beyond class 8
2. The school shall abide by the provisions of right of children to and compulsory education Act, 2009 and the right of children to free and compulsory education rules, 2011.
3. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed as per sub - section (2) of section 12 of the Act. To receive such reimbursements school shall provide a separate bank account.
4. The school shall not deny admission to any child (a) for lack of age proof,(b) if such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period provided prescribed for admission, (c) on the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
5. The society/school shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child of his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure.
6. No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school;
 - (i) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment;
 - (ii) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education;
 - (iii) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under rule 25
 - (iv) Inclusion of Students with disabilities/special needs as per provision of the Act.
 - (v) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualification as laid under section 23 (I) of the Act. Provided further that the current teachers who, at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualification within a period of 3 years.
 - (vi) The performs its duties specified under sub section (1) of section 24 of the Act and 31 of rules.
 - (vii) The teachers shall not engage himself of herself for private teaching activities.



7. The school shall enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the section 19 of the Act.
8. The school shall maintain the standard and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Act. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection are as given under:-
Areas of school campus
Total built up area;
Area of play ground;
No. of class rooms;
Room for headmaster- cum- officer cum- storeroom;
Separate toilet for boys and girls;
Drinking water facility;
Kitchen for cooking mid day meal;
Barrier free access;
Availability of teaching learning material/play sports equipments/library.
9. No unrecognized classes shall run with in the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
10. The school building or other structures or the ground are not used during the day or night for commercial or residential purpose (except for the purpose of residency of any employee of the school) or for political or non-educational activity of any kind what so ever.
11. The school is run by a society registered under the societies registration Act, 1860 (2) of 186). or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force.
12. The school is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other persons.
13. The accounts should be audited and certified by a chartered accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy each of the statements of accounts should be sent to the district education officer every year.
14. The recognition code number allotted to 210 this may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with this officer.
15. The school furnishes such reports and information as may be required by the state governments/district education officer from time to time and complies with such instructions of the state government/local authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.
16. Other condition as per annexure-4 enclosed.
17. Renewal of registrations of society if any is ensured.
18. The recognition shall be withdrawn if the contravention of the provision of the Act, the rules and conditions of recognition of recognition is found and proved.


